## *Lincoln Park Hospital Downzoning Ordinance Deferred*

Dear Friend:

As you know, I have pledged to use my best efforts to mitigate the impact of the Lincoln Park Hospital development on the community. The development was approved by City Council shortly before I took office and building permits were issued for the grocery store, which is now under construction.

I introduced an ordinance when I took office to downzone the entire site in an effort to provide a forum for constructive conversations with the developer to occur.

Such discussions are now underway. Therefore, I have decided to defer the hearing on the downzoning ordinance which is planned for tomorrow, July 12. No action on the proposed ordinance will take place tomorrow, and I will let you know the date of the new hearing.
