Dear Friends,

As many of you know, every year, each alderman is allocated \$1.2 million to spend on local infrastructure improvements. The aldermen can pick from a "menu" of repairs, including street resurfacing, sidewalk replacement, street light painting and repair, or even bicycle lanes.

To prepare for our submission to the City, and to help develop a multi-year plan of improvements, this year we asked for your input. Over a hundred ward residents walked with us over every block and alley of the 43rd Ward.

Grading on a scale of 1-3 (with 1 being the best and 3 being the worst), we graded all the [streets, sidewalks and curbs](#), and [alleys and alley aprons](#) in the ward.

With our [2011 Menu](#) projects either completed or in progress, we were excited to have so much data available to make good decisions for our [2012 Menu](#) submissions.

Check out our [website](#) for interactive maps of our 2011 projects and 2012 Menu submissions. Next, the city departments will give us cost figures for each project. If we can't afford all these projects this year, they'll go into the hopper for next year.

Thanks to your hard work, we now have an inventory of needed infrastructure improvements. You can see the status of your street - and you can see where some of your hard-earned tax dollars go.

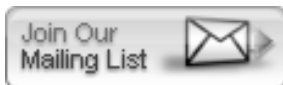
